

CustomContent module manual

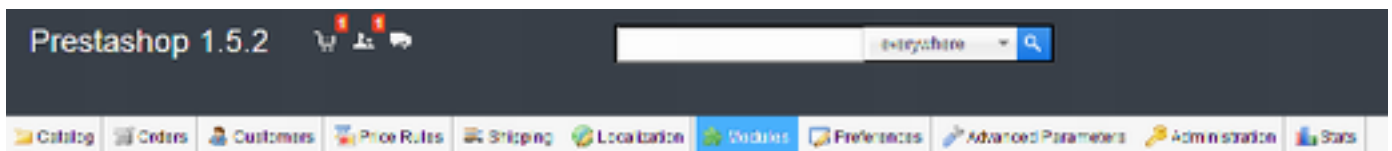
CustomContent module is developed to let you put any number of images, banners or HTML code blocks to the desired hooks (left, right or top) without duplicating the module itself.

At the moment module contains only English translation

Installation

In order to install module please extract 'customcontent' folder from the downloaded 'customcontent.zip' file and upload it to the modules directory of your Prestashop root.

When you are done uploading the files please open Prestashop backend and go to 'Modules' page.



From the 'Categories' block select the 'Other modules' link.

In the modules list you should see 'customcontent' module



Click Install button to install the module.

Module data is provided with several sample items so you'll have content straight after module installation.

Configuration

To access module configuration settings please click 'Configure' button under the successful installation message



At the module configuration screen you can manage module items. Each item is a block that can be placed to the selected hook. Each item can contain image, image link or some HTML code.



Using the Hook select box you can define where to output the module. At the moment three hooks are available: left, right and top.

Using the flag icon right to the 'HTML' textarea you can define custom HTML content for each language used in your store.

Click 'Save' button at the top or at the bottom of the items list to save your changes.

To **add new item**, scroll down to the items list and click Add new item button.

To delete items use the 'Delete item' check box in the item's left top corner. When you check it, the item's container will be painted in red so you'll be able to see the items that will be removed. To complete item delete procedure click 'Save' button. All selected items will be removed.

Transplaning a module

Customcontent module is transplanted to the allowed hooks on installation however if you want to remove or transplant module to the hook manually please do the following.

In Prestashop Backend please go to 'Modules> Positions' page. Click Transplant a module button.

From the 'Module' select 'customcontent'. From the 'Hook into' field select desired hook. Custom content module can be placed only to the 'Left column blocks', 'Right column blocks' and 'Top of pages' hooks.

Editing module layout

Module layout (HTML markup with Smarty tags) is located in the .tpl files in the '/modules/customcontent/views/templates/hook' directory. Each file represents specific hook.

We recommend to move .tpl files to your theme directory before editing. Put .tpl files to the '/themes/your_theme/modules/customcontent/' directory, they you are free to edit the .tpl files. Future module updates won't override your changes.
